Thanks for participating in our “Have a Go Day” programme at the Right Karts Raceway. We hope you enjoyed the thrill of the experience. So you are keen to have more fun with karting? The information here will help get you started.

What race class should I be in?

There are four basic classes that overlap the age range which determine what type of kart you can race in.

| 1. 6 years to under 11 years. | Cadet |
| 2. 9 years to under 13 years. | Mini Rok / Junior Restricted |
| 3. 12 years to under 17 years. | Junior |
| 4. 15 years and over. | Senior |

The Junior and Senior classes have various sub classes in them. Speak to our Have a Go people or the kart shops to help you decide what sub class would best suit you.

Buying your first kart

We highly recommend that you purchase a second hand kart from a kart shop or a known person at our kart club. You may find cheap deals on Trade Me or the Kartsport website, www.kartsport.org.nz However cheap deals could cost you a lot more if you either buy the wrong type of kart or if the seller is less than truthful about what they are selling. Kart shops are there for the repeat business and buying your kart from them is the beginning of an on-going relationship. Buying from a club member maybe slightly cheaper than from a kart shop, however you will regularly see them at the track on race days to come.

Buying your safety clothing and equipment

Equally important as buying your kart is buying the other safety gear that you will require. There are certain things to look out for when purchasing. Some of the basics are: -

1. Helmet
Has a racing life of 10 years from the manufacture date printed inside the helmet.
2. Neck Brace
Not compulsory, but highly recommended.
3. Race suit
Needs to be a CIK approved. If in doubt ask at a kart shop. Beware of buying suits either new or used online. They may not comply with the standard required.

Helmets, race suits and gloves are checked for compliance before every race meeting. If they don't comply you don't race.

Joining a club

To be eligible to race at any Kartsport affiliated track in New Zealand you need to be a financial member of a kart club. Please see the membership form attached. A unique feature of being a member of Kartsport Mt Wellington is the ability to hire a track key for you to use all year round at your convenience, provided of course that the track is not closed for another purpose such as a "Have a Go" day. This lets you practice in your own time without being dictated to as some other clubs have to in order to comply with their resource consent conditions.

Don't forget that because you have participated in our Have a go programme we will give you a discount off your first membership fee for the amount you have paid for the Have a Go day.

Obtaining a practice and then a race licence

Not only do you have to belong to a club but you also need to have a practice or race licence for the class you wish to race in. The application form for this is at the Kartsport website, www.kartsport.org.nz under "Services" → "Download".

Have you got the right tyres?

Kartsport NZ control the tyres that we are permitted race on. It is important that you ensure you have the correct wet & dry tyres, otherwise you will not be permitted to race.

First race day

Take a look at the calendar on our website www.ksmw.org.nz to see when the race days are. There are generally 12 race days spread evenly over the full year. There is an excellent page on the www.kartsport.org.nz website under "Getting Started" → "First Race Day"
