HAVE A GO KARTS

V7 August 2018

PREVIEW

This document sets out requirements, including minimum safety requirements, for Have A Go karts which are not a current KartSport New Zealand class compliant kart.

CHASSIS

1. All chassis must be of sound construction and designed on the same principles as current Sprint class chassis. (ie no roll hoops, high mounted gravity feed fuel tanks, etc)
2. Nose cone must be fitted.
3. Side pods must be fitted.
4. Rear bumper (Steel or a Rear Protection Pod) must be fitted.
5. Chain guard must be fitted.

TYRES AND RIMS

1. Rims to be of metallic construction and one piece.
2. Front rims/hubs to be retained by central nylock nut.
3. Rear rims to be mounted to hub by minimum of 3 studs and nuts.
4. Tyres may be a current Sprint contracted tyre (Dunlop, Mojo or Vega).
5. Tyres may be a previously contracted tyre (MG, Mojo, Bridgestone, Dunlop).
6. Tyres must be a 5" tyre constructed for the purpose of tarmac kart racing and have an appropriate speed rating.

SCRUTINEERING

1. **ALL KARTS MUST BE SCRUTINEERED FOR BASIC SAFETY COMPLIANCE AND INTEGRITY OF CHASSIS.**
2. Steering systems must be securely mounted and fit for purpose.
3. Brakes must be securely mounted, adjusted correctly and have the ability to stop kart as required.
4. Seat secured.
5. Check for dangerous projections.
6. Check that all components are securely attached to kart.
7. Check that a secondary throttle return device (spring) is operational.

ENGINE SIZE AND AGE GROUP

1. 6 to 12 years Age Group: maximum of 85cc two stroke engine or equivalent hp output engine. NO GEARBOX karts/engines permitted.
2. 12 to 16 years Age Group: maximum of 125cc Junior Rotax Max Junior two stroke engine or equivalent hp output engine. NO GEARBOX karts/engines permitted.
3. 16 to 20 years Age Group: maximum of 125cc two stroke engine or equivalent hp output engine.
4. 20 + years Age Group: maximum of 250cc two stroke engine or equivalent hp output engine.

ENGINE TYPE

Only one engine is permitted on the kart. The following types of engine are permitted:

1. Two stroke
2. Four stroke (otto cycle)
3. Electric (must be approved by the KartSport New Zealand National Technical Officer)
4. Diesel
5. Rotary cycle engines NOT PERMITTED.
6. Two stroke, four stroke and diesel engines must be single cylinder.

FUEL

1. Commercially available Pump Petrol or Diesel ONLY
2. OR commercially available battery for electric powered karts.

SAFETY APPAREL

1. Helmet as per KartSport New Zealand Rule G2
2. Overalls as per KartSport New Zealand Rule G3
3. Gloves must be worn.
4. Footwear to be worn and must fully enclose the foot and be of appropriate construction.

INDEMNITY

All drivers (and guardians if applicable) must fill out the Club's Have A Go Indemnity Form.

TRANSPONDERS

Transponders will NOT be used as these karts are for Have A Go purposes only.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

PERFORMED BY EITHER A KARTSPORT NEW ZEALAND RACE OFFICIAL OR A CURRENT MEMBER OF THE HOST CLUB'S COMMITTEE.

ALL DRIVERS MUST ATTEND A DRIVERS BRIEFING AND BE BRIEFED ON THE MEANING OF THE FLAGS TO BE USED AND THE PROCEDURE FOR STOPPING IF A RED FLAG IS DISPLAYED.

TRACK TIME

1. All sessions will start from the Dummy Grid and will be for a maximum time of 10 minutes.
2. There WILL NOT be any simulated starts.
3. The end of a session will be indicated by the showing of a Chequered Flag.
4. Mixed Age Group sessions/fields are NOT PERMITTED.
5. The Number of karts on the track at any one time will be managed by the Club with a view to the driver(s) ability. Maximum of ten karts on track at any one time.
6. All Flag Points must be manned by Flag Marshalls
